The DITB enables you to engage your legislator and the legislative staff in a dialogue on HR issues of concerns to SHRM members. These types of activities all work toward building lasting relationships which will allow you to share your knowledge and expertise on the issues with your fellow chapter and state members, your elected officials, and others ultimately advancing the HR profession!
